The conference papers attracted 16 invited papers (well, the invitees still had to be attracted to presenting because we couldn't offer much!) from Australian presenters; 8 invited papers from US presenters; and 1 paper from The Netherlands. Contributed papers also came from a number of overseas countries apart from New Zealand, including South Africa and PNG. In all, there were 7 oral papers and 3 poster papers from overseas, New Zealand delegates made a strong contribution with 6 oral papers and 8 poster papers; and 45 Australian oral papers and 31 poster papers. (Some of the numbers may have a degree of error! But around 125 papers were presented.)
